VOICE OF VICTORY SCHOOL NEWS

ARRIVAL AND DISMISSAL PROCEDURES

Drop off begins at 7:45 am for all students in grades K-8. Preschool drop-off starts at 8:00 am. Please do not drop your child(ren) off before 7:45 am.

REMINDER PK/K HAVE 11:30 AM DISMISSAL THIS WEEK.

ARRIVAL:

Preschool:

- All carpools enter South Lot and follow PK lane and pull up to door around back of gym by the playground.
- Drop off time starts at 8:00 am.
- Parents are asked to help their child get out of the car seat and gather belongings.
- Exit up the hill through North Lot.
- If you would like to walk your child into school, please park behind church and walk down the hill. Please watch for traffic.

Kindergarten - 8:

- All carpools dropped off in South Lot only.
- Drop off time starts at 7:45 am.
- All cars should pull up to STOP line in single file, and students should enter through cafeteria doors.
- Students will go directly to their classroom.
- **DISMISSAL:** To ensure the safety of every child dismissed as a car rider, the following dismissal plan will be facilitated and supervised by school personnel. School personnel will supervise the students as they walk out into the parking lots.

Preschool - including PK carpools:

- Park in South Lot.
- Proceed to doors in between main school building and gym.
- Staff member will bring your child to you.

Preschool - half day pick up:

- Park in the lot behind the Church.
- Walk down cemetery path to back door by Field 5.
- Staff member will bring child out to you.

Kindergarten - 8:

- All carpools picked up in North Lot.
- Students will be released in a staggered fashion.
- When all the children are safely in their vehicles, a supervising teacher will motion to the first car in the first row to begin exiting. Cars will then exit row by row in an orderly fashion. Any late-arriving vehicles will be directed to the end of the line. No children will be dismissed to these cars until the first wave of vehicles has left. Drivers are asked not to elongate the first rows by wrapping along the back of the lot. This creates congestion and limits visibility.
- At no time will children be allowed to run or walk in the parking lot while vehicles are exiting. We ask that all vehicles park in a forward direction so that no one has to put his/her vehicle in reverse to exit. Once all of the vehicles have exited, school personnel will walk any remaining students back to the main entry in front of the office to wait for their parents. No child will be left unattended.
- Our objective is to minimize the opportunity for unfortunate accidents by creating and maintaining a safe and orderly system for dismissal. We ask that no vehicles be parked in front of the Church for a quick exit. All vehicles must be parked behind the church. All vehicles must follow the traffic pattern out of the parking lot. At no time is it permissible to park along the Church and leave the parking lot when you have your child. We hope that all parents and guardians will cooperate to achieve this goal. Parents who do not follow these safety guidelines will be asked to make alternate dismissal arrangements.

- VOICE OF VICTORY: Each week a newsletter will be emailed to all parents on Thursdays. We call our weekly
 newsletter the Voice of Victory (VOV). The newsletter will contain the important highlights for the week. If you
 would rather receive a paper copy of the VOV, please call the school office.
- ONE CALL SYSTEM: Thanks to our generous OLV PTO fundraisers, we have an automated system in place that will enable us to call families in case of emergencies, for school closings/delays, and as a way to communicate other important events. This gives us a way to communicate with families instantly in case of an emergency. I pray that we never have to use it in this way. We will be testing out the One Call system on Thursday afternoon (8/28). When the call comes, Victory's phone number will display on your caller ID, and it will start with an automated message from the hosting company, One Call. At the end of the message, there will be an option to unsubscribe. If you choose to unsubscribe one of your numbers from the system, follow the prompts at the end of the call to unsubscribe. - **PROCEDURES:** We will continue to use the green bin out by the front door for you to drop items off for students. We ask that you ring the bell and let us know you are placing something in the bin, or call the school office. We will get it to your child(ren). If your child needs an early dismissal, please call us when you get here at 513-347-2072, and we will make sure your child gets out to your car safely.
- CHARACTER STRENGTH: Each week we will be introducing a new character strength for the week from the office. We will publish this in the Voice of Victory as well. Please ask your child(ren) what the character strength is and try and practice at home as a family.
